Liturgist: With joy, let us declare with confidence: Congregation: God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were yet sinners Christ died for us. Liturgist: Therefore, we are assured that our sins are forgiven, that we are brought to new life in Christ. Congregation: Thanks be to God. With the joy of knowing His love, let us greet Liturgist: each other in Jesus' name. Congregation: (turning to face each other) The peace of Jesus Christ be with you.

**Distribution of the Bread:** *The body of Christ, given for you.* 

As you pass the bread, please say to the next person: "The body of Christ, given for you."

Upon receipt of the bread, please eat it without waiting, as a sign of your individual and personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.

**Distribution of the Cup:** *The blood of Christ, shed for you.* 

As you pass the cup, please say to the next person: "The blood of Christ, shed for you."

Upon receipt of the cup, please hold it until all have been served so that we can partake of the cup together, as a sign of our oneness in Christ and membership in His corporate body—the Christian Church.
