




Decadence


- What if many of the "cutting edge" discipleship materials are really just repackaged from early generations? Common example, the Willow Creek model.
- ■What if the way forward is to bring back the classical catechism model into the public setting?
- ■This is not for nostalgic reasons. But because it truly works!



Definition of Public

- ■The book of Acts records the importance of public worship, public prayer, and public gathering of the people of God (Acts 2:42-47, 4:32-37).
- ■Evangelicalism prioritizes piety over churchliness.
- I think we could use some more discipline in our lives over against unbridled freedom.

Preaching

- The first way we are publicly catechized is through preaching.
- ■The Reformed tradition has preached through books, historically, to teach people to read Scripture well.
- High literacy rates is one of the gifts of Protestantism to the world.



Generic Evangelical Churches Preach Well....

- ■But they do not catechize well. Presbyterians, Lutherans, and Anglicans have the upper hand to disciple well, I believe.
- Discipleship can be even seen as optional!
- Data points towards the collapse of the movement in the future.



Prayer

- ■The Book of Common Prayer (1966) has a daily office for prayer.
- ■We could host morning prayer in the future.
- Public prayer is prioritized in Acts!



Public Prayer

- What if we challenged our people to come to morning prayer in the future?
- Once we have a more permanent worship space, we will complete the Lord's Day by offering an evening prayer/catechism service.
- This "keeps us honest" by truly keeping the Lord's Day.
