## Greetings Friends,

Several years ago, the Board of "Hope For Renewal" drafted the mission statement that we exist to serve so that we may build relationships to share the love of Christ to those who live along the Glenwood Avenue corridor. This summer we are seeing the fruit of following the mission that God has given us.

The Playground Ministry which was started last summer has, in its second year, been an incredible opportunity to follow the mission that God has given to us. The foundation of the playground ministry was to serve the community by providing a weekly meal. This summer we are seeing 50



to 100 adults and children come to share a meal together with us. That translates into 100–150 hot dogs each week. But so much more has transpired through that. We have seen a sense of community and fellowship that is beyond anything that we imagined would happen. We added a weekly community-building activity as part of the picnic. Relationships have grown in numbers and have deepened as we spend time with those who come for dinner. We now have a weekly ministry team from Tabernacle and those from the neighborhood involved. Through relationships we have seen the need to start Men's and Women's Bible studies. Studies will meet bimonthly beginning in August. In September we will begin a monthly "Community Prayer Night" at the Hope For Renewal building. The invitation to the residents of the Glenwood Ave. community will be simple..... "Come and pray for the needs of our community".





## **Building Update:**

We are still in the process of rehabbing the building. We have a goal to have the first floor of the building finished to the stage where we can move the Playground Community Ministry to the building on November 7<sup>th</sup>.



We still have a few major projects to complete before then. Please contact Gary for more details of projects if you have skilled and nonskilled workers who would be willing to come for a Saturday work day in September and October.



We now prayer walk the neighborhood three mornings a week. We walk and pray but we also have the opportunity to meet, greet and build relationships with those in the community. Give us a call if you desire to walk with us!
