Status of our precious church body early this week, the Worst of Times! Leadership couple both have covid, one man diagnosed with colon cancer, one young lady homeless and expecting a baby in July, one aunt who is grieving over the loss of her 18yr old niece to a shooting, husband and father with an unknown illness hospitalized, several serious relationship issues and the continuing addiction issues as strongholds.

Three days later, the Best of Times! God's Word in Romans 12, our last sermon series, becomes real and powerful.

Our church body rallies in prayer and care as we see Gods hand in colon surgery give incredible hope. We see the grieving aunt minister with a homeless woman in the café, many tears. We see willingness with meals and supplies to meet needs. We hear of the man with colon cancer having breakfast the day before surgery with one of our young men with addiction issues. We see hard conversation and confession over addiction issues on a sidewalk in our neighborhood, We see the body using their gifts to serve each other. This week has been a huge struggle and yet an incredible gift from God to see our young church body put God Word into belief and action. Please continue to pray for our church body!
